NOTE: This is not a recreational hunting opportunity but uses the established draw system as the most effective way for eligible Albertans to apply for participation in the responder program.

The Wildlife Management Responder Network is made up of a select number of qualified Albertans to help deal with Grizzly Bear conflicts.

The draw system is an opportunity for Alberta residents to apply to become a Wildlife Responder.

Applicants can select 1 area based on the Wildlife Responder Program – Grizzly Bear map on page 41.

IMPORTANT:

- 1. Because this is a unique draw, with no licences being allocated, the draw priority system will not be applied to this draw. Each applicant will be selected on a random basis and no priority will be assigned to the applicants not drawn.
- 2. Applicants must apply individually. Group applications are not available for this draw.
- 3. Each applicant must have a valid 10-digit Wildlife Identification Number (WiN), Wildlife Certificate, and must be eligible to hold hunting licences.
- 4. Those selected for a response action will be contacted by telephone and will be required to respond within 24 hours or less of being contacted. They will receive an authorization outlining the area in which they may pursue the animal and the duration for which that authorization is valid. - 5. Actions may include tracking and euthanizing a problem grizzly bear only when deemed appropriate and safe by wildlife enforcement officers.
- 6. The authorization does not allow automatic access to private or any other lands where access or the possession or discharge of a weapon requires permission.
- 7. Lethally managing a grizzly bear will require reporting and delivery of the bear to the government for record keeping and sampling. The responder will be allowed to keep all parts of the bear, except for the gall bladder.
